AOTS Webinar "ORBIOD2" The Program on SDGs oriented innovation in the post COVID-19 era

Organized by The Association for Overseas Technical Cooperation and Sustainable Partnerships (AOTS) in cooperation with AOTS Alumni Societies.

BACKGROUND

The Association for Overseas Technical Cooperation and Sustainable Partnerships (AOTS) is an organization for human resources development mainly in overseas countries to promote technical cooperation through training, experts dispatch and other programs. The Program on Business Innovation and Organization Development (BIOD) is one of the management training programs which is conducted by AOTS with the subsidy of Japanese Government.

Due to the global spread of COVID-19, however, it is impossible for us to invite the participants to Japan and implement a two-week management training program this year. As an alternative, we will implement a webinar (online seminar) titled "the program on SDGs oriented innovation in the post COVID-19 era," featuring one of the core pillars of the BIOD and enabling participants to learn the essence of the topics safely at home.

OUTLINE

As the COVID-19 pandemic has changed the global business environment, business innovation has become ever more important to survive the uncertain times. While the traditional framework of commercial activities at companies is now fundamentally reviewed, there is an increasing call for the necessity of efforts to solve social issues through business.

This webinar will introduce participants to the examples of efforts to address the challenges of the Post-Corona world by Japanese and global companies, as well as provide input and facilitation on SDGs and innovation from the lecturer, in order for participants to receive hints to create business plans allowing themselves to respond to and survive the uncertain times. Rather than a one-way teaching, this program focuses on discussions among participants from various countries.

The webinar aims to help company owners, executives, and senior managers who have responsibility in the field of cooperative development, human resource development, and organizational development to achieve the following goals:

- 1) To understand the global trends regarding SDGs and what "innovation" is
- 2) To understand the key viewpoints to create business innovation
- 3) To understand the characteristics of Japanese and global companies through examples of business innovation that solves social issues through business
- 4) To acquire essential elements of business plan planning and knowledge necessary for planning
