BACKGROUND

The Association for Overseas Technical Cooperation and Sustainable Partnerships (AOTS) is an organization for human resources development mainly in overseas countries to promote technical cooperation through training, experts dispatch and other programs. Through those programs, we aim at contributing to the mutual economic growth of developing countries and Japan as well as enhancing friendly relations among those countries.

AOTS Webinar KRVN03 "Introduction to Safety Basic Assessor for Vietnam - Guide on Machinery Safety at the Industry 4.0 Era -" is an online seminar (webinar) designed for company owners, managers and engineers mainly in manufacturing companies in Vietnam who want to raise safety awareness at the manufacturing site and want to know how to achieve both productivity and safety.

OUTLINE

Although safety is the basis of corporate activities, accidents caused by using machines still exist at manufacturing sites. Inappropriate safety management leads to increased costs and delays in production planning, which is a major factor in reducing productivity. Safety measures at manufacturing sites focused on safety guards and emergency stops until recently, but lately, technologies have been developed to realize new safety concepts such as "unstoppable safety." In other words, we have more safety options making us easier to achieve both productivity and safety.

This webinar will be implemented for company owners, executives, managers, supervisors, and engineers in manufacturing companies in Laos. An instructor from Technology Promotion Association (Thailand – Japan) (TPA)* will explain an overview on machine safety.

*TPA is a non-profit organization in Thailand established in 1973 for the purpose of transferring and disseminating the latest technology and knowledge from Japan to Thailand and human resource development in Thailand. TPA has operated the "Safety Basic Assessor (SBA)" certification system in Thailand since 2018 with a cooperation with Nippon Electric Control Equipment Industries Association (NECA) and provided training programs on machinery safety.

OBJECTIVES

We aim for company owners, executives, managers, supervisors, and engineers in manufacturing companies in Vietnam to achieve the following goals:

- 1) Aware the importance and have the consciousness of safety of machinery.
- 2) Understand safety standards in the field of machinery to be used as a reference in machine safety design.
- 3) Acknowledge the basics of machine safety risk assessment and risk reduction in order to improve the existing machines.

- 4) Acknowledge the safety equipment for machine and use appropriately.
