# AOTS Webinar Introduction to the QC Story -QC Problem-Solving methods as a basis of TQM-

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Association for Overseas Technical Cooperation and Sustainable Partnerships (AOTS) is an organization for human resources development mainly in overseas countries to promote technical cooperation through training, experts dispatch and other programs. We usually invite overseas trainees to Japan and implement two-week management training programs using a subsidy from the Japanese Government, but due to the global spread of COVID-19 this year, it is impossible for us to do so.

"Introduction to the QC Story -QC Problem-Solving methods as a basis of TQM-" is one of online seminars (webinar) of the management training program as a new way, for all developing countries which enables the participants to learn the essence of the topic safely at home.

### OUTLINE

QC Problem-Solving methods are indispensable as the basis of TQM, in order to promote quality management. QC story starts with recognizing the gap between the current and ideal status as a problem, and sets steps of how to solve the problem effectively and efficiently. Participants should understand QC story, QC-like perspective, and way of thinking of QC story as problem-solving steps to address quality problems in their organizations as a whole.

- 2) To understand the ways of thinking of QC Problem-Solving methods
