


#### **Job Duties:-**

- Organise regional seminars for members on relevant topics connected with employment and other areas of administration in the plantations sector




### **COVID-19 IMPACT ON PLANTATION SECTOR**

WHY AND HOW TO OVERCOME?







- 1. Labour Intensive Sector
- 2. "3D" Jobs Dirty, Difficult & Dangerous
- 3. Highly Dependence on Foreign Workers
- About 70% of the workforce in estate are Foreign Workers
- 75,000 labour shortage nationwide currently
- 4. About 20-30% shortfall in potential production
- Translated into loss of revenue of MYR 10 to 12 Billion in a year
- 5. Freeze on recruitment of Foreign Workers due to the COVID-19 since 2020
- 6. COVID-19 on other sectors many local employees retrenched and unemployed
- 7. Still no interest from local employees and why?

#### **High Crude Palm Oil (CPO) Prices**

Estate workers will earn higher "Daily CPO Price Bonus"
